WHO SHOULD ATTEND AND WHY?

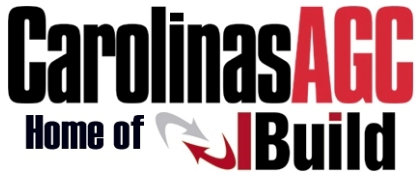
