NEW! NC OSHA has passed a new crane standard that will require every crane or boom truck operator working in NC to be certified by October 1, 2011! **Start working to get your operators certified now!**

3 days of classroom prep, concludes with optional written examinations for the new Nationally Accredited NCCER Crane Operator Certification Program. CAGC is now offering these new exams due to many benefits compared to other crane operator certifications such as:

- ANSI Accredited certification will meet or exceed state and federal OSHA requirements.
- Written exams have 3-hour time limits.
- Use of basic non-programmable calculators is allowed during written exams.
- Written exams may be taken “on demand” at Carolinas AGC, a contractor’s office.
- Scores for exams are available within 20 minutes upon completion.
- NCCER Certified Practical Examiner classes are scheduled for March 4th and November 4th, 2010 in Charlotte. This class will allow qualified individuals to conduct practical exams for your own employees, or others after they have passed the written exams.
