



## Your Role in the Green Environment

Geared to craft workers as well as others with interest in green building, this module provides fundamental instruction in the green environment, green construction practices, and green building rating systems. Material includes the major challenges to the green environment that are caused by the built environment; priorities that matter most for the green environment; the life cycle phases of a building and their impacts on the green environment.. Students will identify green alternatives to conventional building practices and describe the pros and cons of those alternatives; identify specific practices you can implement to improve your impacts on the green environment; describe the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) rating process; identify construction activities that contribute to a project's LEED rating and identify common construction pitfalls that may affect a project's LEED rating.
