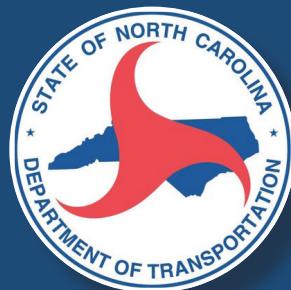

Technical Skills Training for Small Contractors

The N. C. Department of Transportation Technical Training Series is a pilot program that offers small highway construction contractors practical training necessary to successfully work on NCDOT projects. Each course will cover the skills, resources, and requirements necessary to become prequalified to work on NCDOT highway projects, and will provide an in-depth review of the NCDOT specifications and drawings for each type of work. Participants completing these courses will also learn tips and strategies for success from NCDOT engineering staff, prime contractors, and experienced small highway contractors. Construction contractors that are interested in working on upcoming projects are encouraged to register for one or more courses in the series.

- Develop** new construction skills in areas most likely to be needed on upcoming projects
- Enhance** your project management expertise
- Learn** how to do business with prime contractors and NCDOT division offices
- Cultivate** a strategy to competitively market your business for NCDOT contracts
- Network** with other small highway contractors

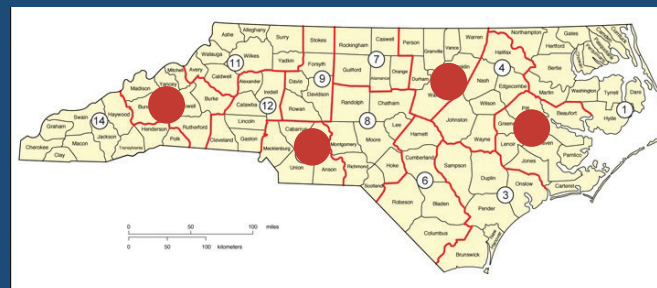
Course Topics and Schedule

Each course is uniquely devoted to a separate type of work required on NCDOT projects. The courses will be taught by NCDOT engineers, prime contractors, and industry professionals. The course topics and schedule for 2023 are as follows:

March	Erosion Control	August	Guardrail Installation
April	Incidental Concrete	September	Work Zone Traffic Control
May	Concrete Barrier/Bridge Rail	October	Water/Sewer and Manhole Adjustments
June	Pavement Markings	November	Utility Installation and Removal

Locations



Courses will be held at NCDOT office locations or community colleges across the state in the areas of Asheville, Charlotte, Greenville and Raleigh, NC.

What You Will Learn

Key areas covered in each session include understanding NCDOT Standard Specifications and Drawings, equipment requirements, bidding and estimating, project management, invoicing and payment, contract compliance and marketing to prime contractors.



About the Program

Program Cost and Class Size

The program is free and limited to 25 firms per class. We can accept two individuals per firm, but any other staffers may be waitlisted for another session if space is not available.

Selection Criteria

The program is for small contractors in the highway construction industry. Graduates will receive a Certificate of Completion after finishing a course in the program. These courses provide an overview of the skills and resources necessary for work on NCDOT projects, but are not certification courses for specific trades.
